

## Local Access Fee (LAF)

The Local Access Fee (LAF) is a fee set in agreement with the City of Calgary that applies to all electric services located within the City of Calgary. It is a fee in lieu of property taxes and other fees or charges payable to the City by ENMAX Power, the operator of the electric distribution utility in Calgary. ENMAX Power collects the fee on a monthly basis from all retail sellers of electricity in Calgary.

The LAF as of February 1, 2012 is:

**LAF Wires Component:**

11.11% of the total revenue from Distribution Tariff rate charges in the billing period,

plus

**LAF Energy Component:**

11.11% of the monthly RRO Energy Charge per kWh of Energy Delivered.

**February 2012 LAF Energy Component Calculation:**

February 2012 RRO Energy Charge	\$0.136898	per kWh
X 11.11%	<b><u>\$0.015209</u></b>	per kWh
