ENMAX Power Corporation (ENMAX) filed Application No. 1569586 with the Alberta Utilities Commission on April 25, 2008 respecting approval to construct a new substation designated as No. 47 Substation, extend existing 138-kV transmission line 138-11.83, and alter existing ENMAX No. 162 Substation in the City of Calgary.

AltaLink Management Ltd. (AltaLink) filed Application No. 1569911 with the Alberta Utilities Commission on April 30, 2008 respecting approval to extend existing 138-kV transmission line 771L to connect the proposed No. 47 Substation to the Alberta Interconnected Electric System.

TAKE NOTICE that any parties having concerns with Application No. **1569586 and/or 1569911** (the Applications) should file an intervention letter with the Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC or the Commission) by **2:30 p.m. on November 12, 2008**. If no bona fide objections are received by the above date, the AUC will process the Applications in accordance with sections 14 and 15 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* without a hearing or other proceeding.

**Nature of the Applications**

ENMAX is proposing to construct a new substation designated as No. 47 Substation (the Substation) to supply growing electrical load and development in the City of Calgary. ENMAX has applied with two locations along Stoney Trail for the proposed Substation (as shown on the first attached map), with Option 1 being the preferred location. ENMAX is also proposing to extend existing transmission line 138-11.83 by constructing approximately 7.2-km of new 138-kV transmission line within the Transportation and Utility Corridor (as shown on the second attached map). The details of the application are more particularly described in Application No. 1569586.

AltaLink is proposing to extend existing transmission line 771L to connect the proposed Substation to the Alberta Interconnected Electric System. Transmission line 771L will be installed on existing structures of transmission line 918L on the north side of Stoney Trail, as more particularly described in Application No. 1569911.

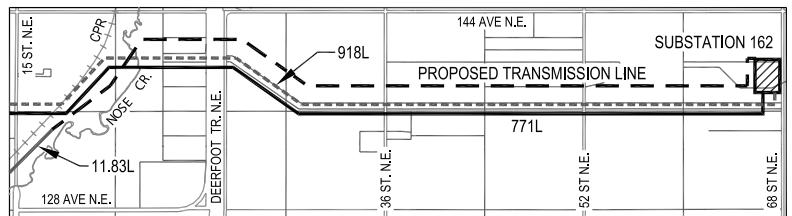
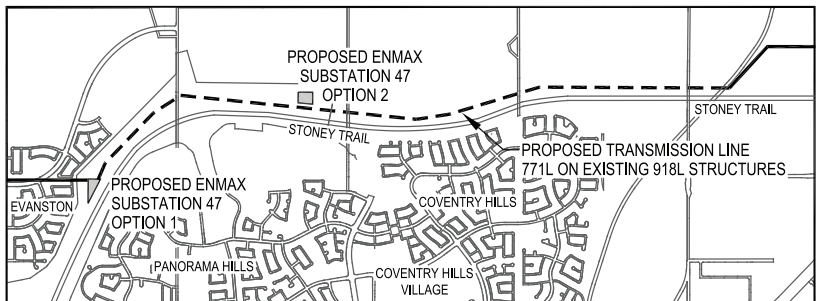

Any party with concerns respecting the Applications should submit an intervention letter setting out the party's name or organization name, address and/or legal land description, telephone number and e-mail address (if available) prior to **2:30 p.m. on November 12, 2008**.

- a description of the nature of the party's interest in the Applications (i.e. how the party may be directly and adversely affected by the Commission's decision); and
- an explanation of the party's position including the reasons why the party believes that the Commission should decide in the manner the party recommends and information in support of the party's position.
