WHAT'S HAPPENING?

The City of Calgary requires ENMAX Power Corporation to relocate existing electrical infrastructure to accommodate the West 17 and 37 Street Main Streets projects. Modifications will include burying overhead power lines and installing associated utility equipment. This relocation ensures the alignment will be ready when City of Calgary crews start road construction in July.

WHERE?

This work will take place within City-owned boulevards at the following locations:

- 17 Avenue SW and 37 Street SW
- 19 Avenue SW and 37 Street SW
- 17 Avenue SW and 29 Street SW

Please note, property access may be required.

WHEN?

ENMAX construction is anticipated to begin the week of June 8, 2020 and will continue for approximately five weeks. Crews will be working Monday to Friday, from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Weekend work may be required.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION?

VISUAL

Please expect the following equipment on-site:

- ENMAX and contractor vehicles (Allteck), bucket trucks and associated utility equipment
- Construction barricades; safety fencing
- Road signage

Restoration of ground conditions will take place following this work, which will include seed and loam and/or asphalt (if applicable).

NOISE

There may be an increase in noise and/or minor vibrations during construction activities. Please be advised we comply with the City of Calgary's Community Standards Noise Bylaw. In the event we are required to temporarily exceed these levels, necessary permits are obtained from the City.

TRAFFIC ACCOMODATIONS

Please expect the following:

- 17 Avenue SW and 37 Street SW (1 – 1.5 weeks):
 - Daily lane closure in the eastbound right lane of 17 Avenue SW and adjacent sidewalk
 - Daily lane closure in southbound right lane of 37 Street SW and adjacent sidewalk
 - Alternating two-way traffic at the intersection (as required)
 - Limited alleyway access
- 19 Avenue and 37 Street SW (approximately three days):
 - Various lane closures (as required)
 - Restricted street parking (follow on-site parking signage)
 - Limited alleyway access
- 17 Avenue and 29 Street SW (1 – 1.5 weeks):
 - Daily lane closure in the eastbound right lane of 17 Avenue SW and adjacent sidewalk
 - Various lane closures (as required)
 - Limited alleyway access

We will make every effort to notify you in advance if your alleyway access/parking will be impacted.

POWER SUPPLY

A power outage may be required to facilitate this work. If you are affected, a notification will be sent to you in advance with the date and time of the outage. This notice will address any outage related questions you may have.
