WHAT'S HAPPENING?

ENMAX Power Corporation is upgrading the electrical services in your community. We will be upgrading the existing overhead transmission infrastructure to accommodate a new development in your area. By doing so, we can support growing electrical needs and continue providing you with safe and reliable power.

WHERE?

This work will take place within an existing utility right-of-way north of Bearspaw Dam Road NW (see attached map).

WHEN?

This work is scheduled to begin **July 6, 2020** and continue for approximately three weeks. Crews will be working Monday to Friday, from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Weekend work may be required.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION?

VISUAL

Please expect the following equipment on-site:

- ENMAX and contractor (Valard Construction) vehicles, bucket trucks and associated utility equipment
- Construction barricades; safety fencing

NOISE

There may be an increase in noise and/or minor vibrations during construction activities. Please be advised we comply with the City of Calgary's Community Standards Noise Bylaw. In the event we are required to temporarily exceed these levels, necessary permits are obtained from the City.

POWER SUPPLY

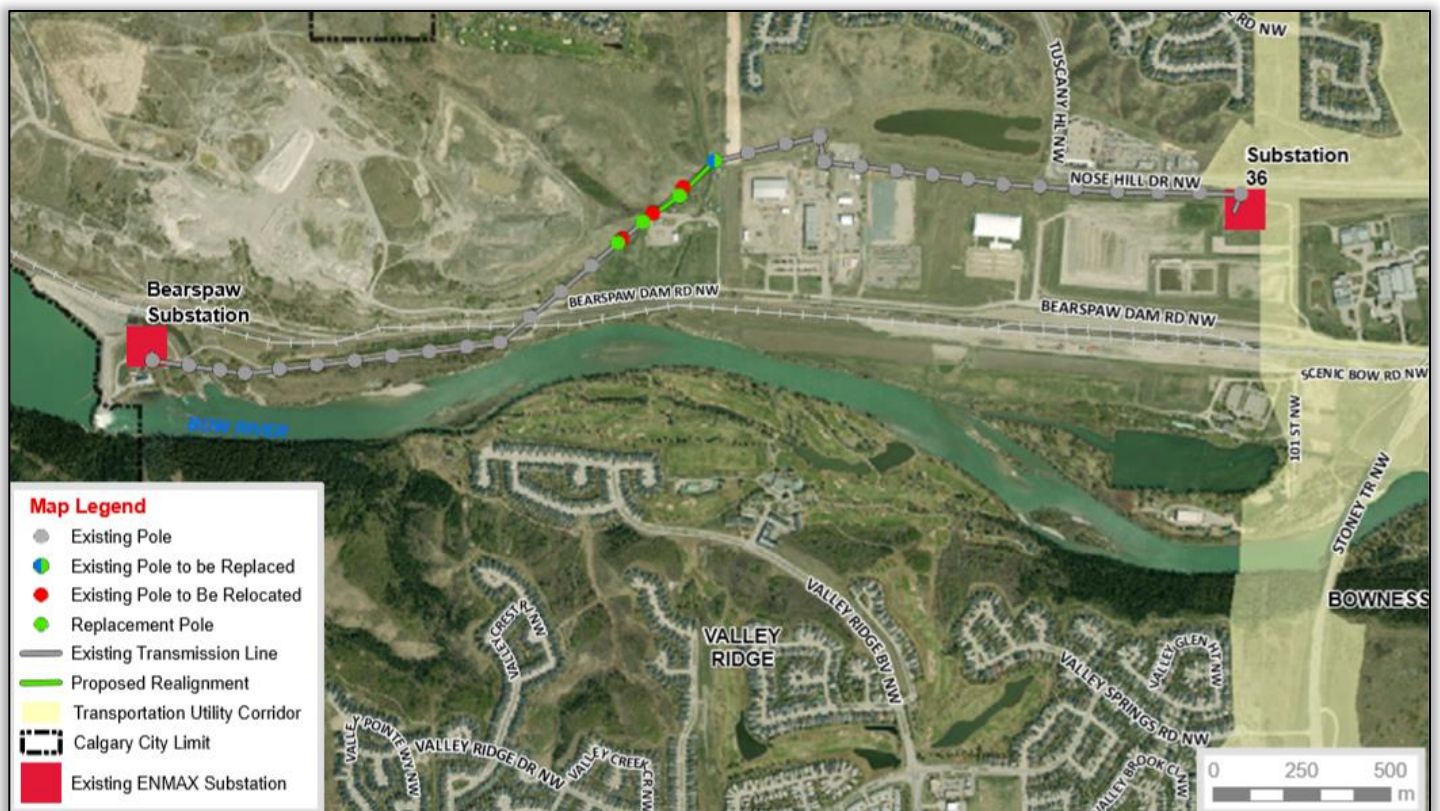
A power outage is not required to facilitate this work.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

UTILITY RIGHT OF WAY (URW)

A utility right-of-way provides protection, safety, and service. URWs are common in urban areas and are usually located adjacent to the residential property line and may contain underground powerlines, transformers, poles or allowances for overhead lines. To ensure your safety, the use of land within URW is restricted. In case of a power failure, electricity must be restored as quickly as possible and access to the URW be kept clear.
