Project Update – TELUS salvage work

WHAT'S HAPPENING?

ENMAX Power Corporation is replacing the existing ENMAX Substation No. 1, located at 738 9 Avenue SW. Originally built in 1912 to power streetlights and the streetcar rail system in downtown Calgary, a new substation is required to ensure the reliability and integrity of ENMAX's transmission system, and to ensure the reliable supply of electricity to the City of Calgary.

In advance of construction starting in Q3 2021, the removal of existing TELUS infrastructure is required. This work will take place in the roadway on 7 Street SW, and in the alleyway west of 7 Street SW, between 8 Avenue SW and 9 Avenue SW.

WHEN?

TELUS removal work will take place the **week of May 24, 2021**. Work is expected to take 1-2 days, and crews will be working between the hours of 7 a.m. and 4 p.m.

For construction work starting in Q3, impacted stakeholders will receive advance notification and additional information once construction dates have been scheduled. Communication efforts will continue through all phases of the project to ensure timely updates are provided to impacted stakeholders.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT ON SITE?

For TELUS salvage work, you can expect to see:

- TELUS vehicles and bucket trucks
- Construction barricades and safety fencing

TRAFFIC ACCOMMODATIONS

- Temporary lane/sidewalk closure along 7 Street SW when crews are working in the existing manhole. Please follow detours in place.
- Alleyway access via 7 Street SW will be temporarily restricted while crews are removing overhead cables. Access will be maintained via 8 Street SW.
- Parkade access in the alleyway will not be impacted by this work.
