



# UTILITY WORK IN YOUR COMMUNITY

## WHAT'S HAPPENING?

ENMAX Power Corporation (EPC) is upgrading the electrical services in your area in order to provide ongoing reliable power for you and your community. EPC will install new cables on several kilometres of existing overhead distribution lines to accommodate both current and future electricity needs. We will be replacing some of the existing distribution poles and anchor supports located in City-owned alleyways and boulevards adjacent to your residence.

## WHERE?

This work will occur between the following locations:

- Radnor Avenue NE and 1 Avenue NE
- 6 Street NE and Deerfoot Trail

**Please note, property access may be required in order to safely perform this work, including fenced yards, to access our infrastructure. Please contact our Customer Relations team via phone or email upon receipt of this letter if you have any questions or concerns regarding crew property access.**

## WHEN?

Construction is scheduled to begin **October 13, 2020** and will continue until the end of December 2020. Crews will be working Monday to Friday, from 7 a.m. until 4 p.m. Weekend work may be required.

## WHAT CAN I EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION?

### VISUAL

Please expect the following equipment on-site:

- ENMAX vehicles, bucket trucks and associated utility equipment
- Construction barricades; safety fencing

**Restoration of ground conditions will take place following this work, which may include seed and loam and/or asphalt (if applicable).**

### TRAFFIC ACCOMMODATIONS

- **Alleyway access may be restricted during construction**
- **Street parking may be limited when crews are replacing electrical infrastructure along roadways**
- **Please ensure the area surrounding our utility equipment is clear of obstructions**

### NOISE

There may be an increase in noise and/or minor vibrations during construction activities. Please be advised we comply with the City of Calgary's Community Standards Noise Bylaw. In the event we are required to temporarily exceed these levels, necessary permits are obtained from the City.

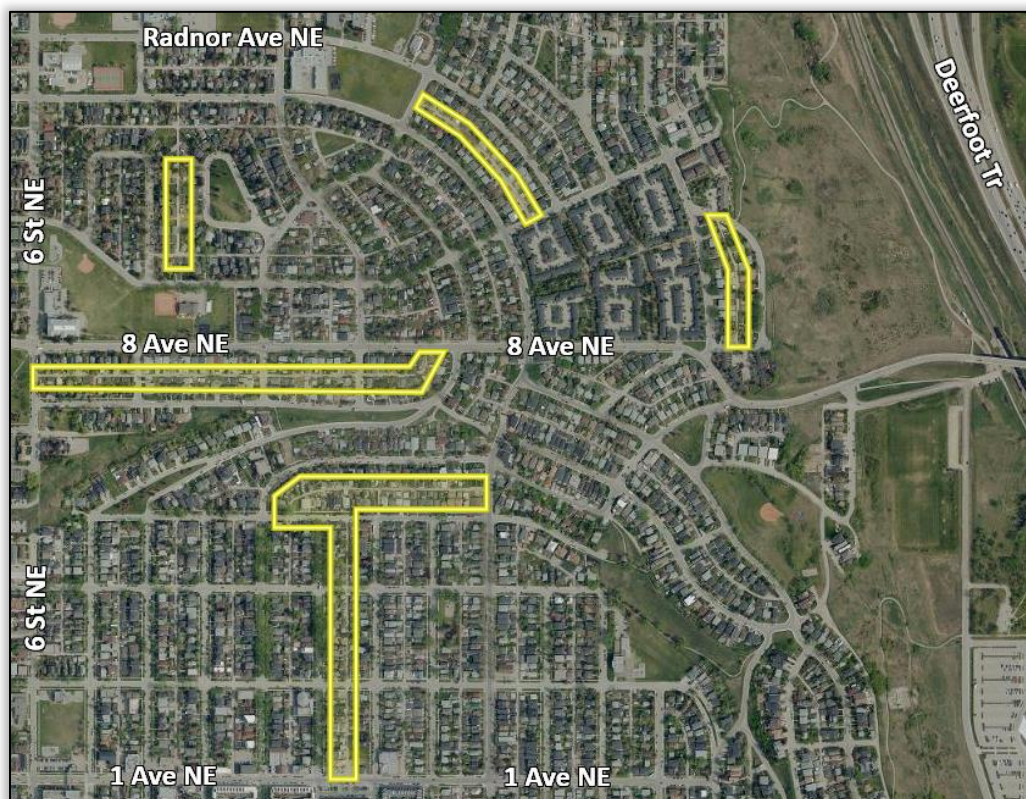
## POWER SUPPLY

Power outages will be required to facilitate this work. Notifications will be sent to you in advance with the dates and times of the outages. These notices will address any outage related questions you may have. Please note, alleyway access will be restricted on the days of the outages.

## TREE TRIMMING

Trees growing too close to overhead lines will be trimmed to maintain safe minimum clearances from power lines, as set out in the Alberta Electrical Utility Code. Tree trimming in your area is scheduled to commence **October 13, 2020**.
