ENMAX Power Corporation New ENMAX No. 35 Substation	Proceeding 2015 Application 2015-A001

ENMAX Power Corporation (ENMAX) by Application 2015-A001, registered on January 30, 2015, applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for approval to construct and operate a substation designated as ENMAX No. 35 substation in southwest Calgary.

The Commission, pursuant to sections 14, 15 and 19 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*, approved the application in Decision 2015-D01-2015¹ and granted to ENMAX a permit to construct and a licence to operate the substation, subject to the provisions of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations made under the acts, any orders made under the acts, the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, and the following terms and conditions:

1. The substation shall be wholly located in Block C, Plan 6045JK in the northwest quarter of Section 19, Township 23, Range 1, west of the Fifth Meridian.
2. Specifications of the substation shall include the following:
 - a) Two 138/13.8-kilovolt (kV), 18/24/30-megavolt ampere transformers.
 - b) Four 138-kV circuit breakers.
 - c) Fourteen 138/13.8-kV motor operated disconnects.
 - d) An enclosure surrounded by a chain link fence and other substation equipment as described in the application.
3. ENMAX shall file with the Commission within 30 days of completing the substation, the energization certificate for the substation issued by ENMAX Power Corporation to confirm that the substation has been completed and is being operated in accordance with the provisions of this permit and licence.
4. Unless otherwise authorized by the Commission construction of the substation shall be completed by October 31, 2017.
