Re: Cancellation of Calgary Energy Centre Peaking Plant (CEC 2) Connection Project

Thank you for your participation in the CEC 2 Connection Project. You may have received information regarding this project previously in October 2017. The purpose of this notification is to inform stakeholders that the CEC 2 Connection Project has been cancelled.

On February 4, 2020 the Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) cancelled Calgary Energy Centre No. 2 Inc.'s request for system access service and the connection project has been cancelled. Project Background

On June 30, 2016, the Alberta Utilities Commission approved the request to expand the Calgary Energy Centre to include a 197 megawatt peaking plant CEC 2. Connection of the CEC 2 to the transmission grid would have required ENMAX Power Corporation (EPC) to construct a new substation and 138 kV transmission line connecting to EPC's existing ENMAX No. 162 Substation.
