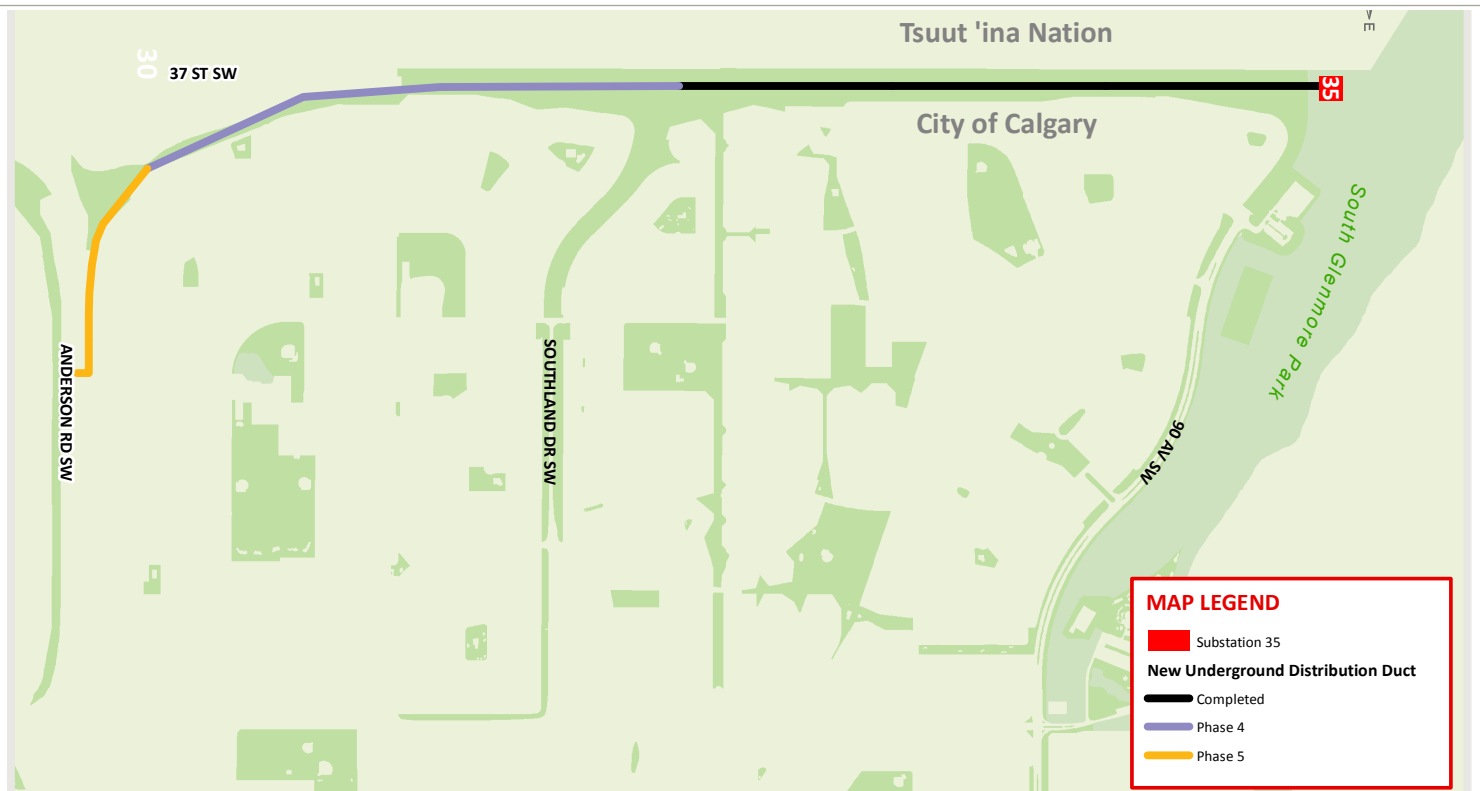


RING ROAD UPDATE - DISTRIBUTION

PROJECT DETAILS

ENMAX is continuing our work to relocate distribution to accommodate the Calgary Southwest Ring Road. Last year, we completed three 700 metre sections of underground duct from 90 Avenue SW to Southland Drive.

In January, Graham Construction began work on Substation 35 near 90 Avenue in South Glenmore Park. The substation building construction will last approximately 10 months. Once the building is constructed, additional work will continue on the substation.

In March 2016, our crews will continue building the underground distribution duct in two sections, Phase 4 and Phase 5, from Southland Drive to where the duct will cross under Anderson Road SW near the new pedestrian bridge. To complete this part of the project, a blue construction fence will be installed to secure the work area. The pathway will be closed in order for us to complete the work safely and detour signs will be posted to direct cyclists to the temporary route.

Also beginning this year, our crews will be installing cables in the new underground distribution duct starting near 90 Avenue SW to Anderson Road. This work is weather permitting and will last until the end of the year.
