Project Update – Revised Start Date

WHAT'S HAPPENING?

ENMAX Power Corporation is replacing the existing ENMAX Substation No. 1, located at 738 9 Avenue SW. Originally built in 1912 to power streetlights and the streetcar rail system in downtown Calgary, a new substation is required to ensure the reliability and integrity of ENMAX's transmission system, and to ensure the reliable supply of electricity to the City of Calgary.

ENMAX has recently awarded the contract for the Engineering, Procurement and Construction firm who will be responsible for the detailed design and construction of the Project. Based on the construction timelines given by the successful proponent, **ENMAX estimates that the start of construction will be delayed to Q2 2022.**

WHEN?

With the **revised project start date targeted for Q2 2022**, the completion date is now anticipated for Q2 2025.

For construction work starting in Q2 of 2022, impacted stakeholders will receive advance notification and additional information once construction dates have been scheduled. Communication efforts will continue through all phases of the project to ensure timely updates are provided to impacted stakeholders.
