Exploratory drilling work to now occur March 11, 2022.

Demolition of former Knoxville's Tavern building to now begin March 25 and continue until mid-April 2022.

Work times:

Weekdays, 7 a.m. - 5 p.m. Some weekend and after hours work will be required.

What's happening?

ENMAX Power Corporation is replacing the existing ENMAX Substation No. 1, located at 738 9 Avenue SW. Originally built in 1912 to power streetlights and the streetcar rail system in downtown Calgary, a new substation is required to ensure the reliability and integrity of ENMAX's transmission system, and to ensure the reliable supply of electricity to the City of Calgary. The new substation will be located at 830 9 Avenue SW.

In advance of construction starting, exploratory drilling work is required at the new substation site. Demolition of the former Knoxville's Tavern building located at 840 9 Avenue SW is also required. We understand that this work may create some inconveniences, and we thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we deliver on our commitment to provide reliable power to all Calgarians.

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What to expect:

We make every effort to minimize the effect our work has on daily activities, and we follow all applicable standards and bylaws. Below are the things to be aware of related to this project.

Revised Project Timeline:

- **March 11, 2022:** Exploratory drilling work to test ground conditions at 830 9 Avenue SW.
- **Targeting March 25 until mid-April 2022:** Demolition of former Knoxville's Tavern.
- **Beginning of May 2022:** Construction of the new ENMAX Substation No. 1 will begin.

Impacted stakeholders will receive ongoing notification and additional information throughout the duration of this project.

During drilling and demolition work, expect to see:

- ENMAX, Graham and contractor vehicles, including excavators, skid steers, dump trucks and associated utility equipment.
- Construction barricades and safety fencing.
- Project and road signage.

Road closures, detours, parking and access:

- Intermittent lane and sidewalk closures along 9 Avenue SW, 7 Street SW and 8 Street SW will be required; please follow signage.
- Alleyway access may be limited to only one entry/exit point at certain times; however, parkade access will be maintained; please follow signage.
- A flagger will be present to facilitate vehicle access when work is required in the alleyway.
