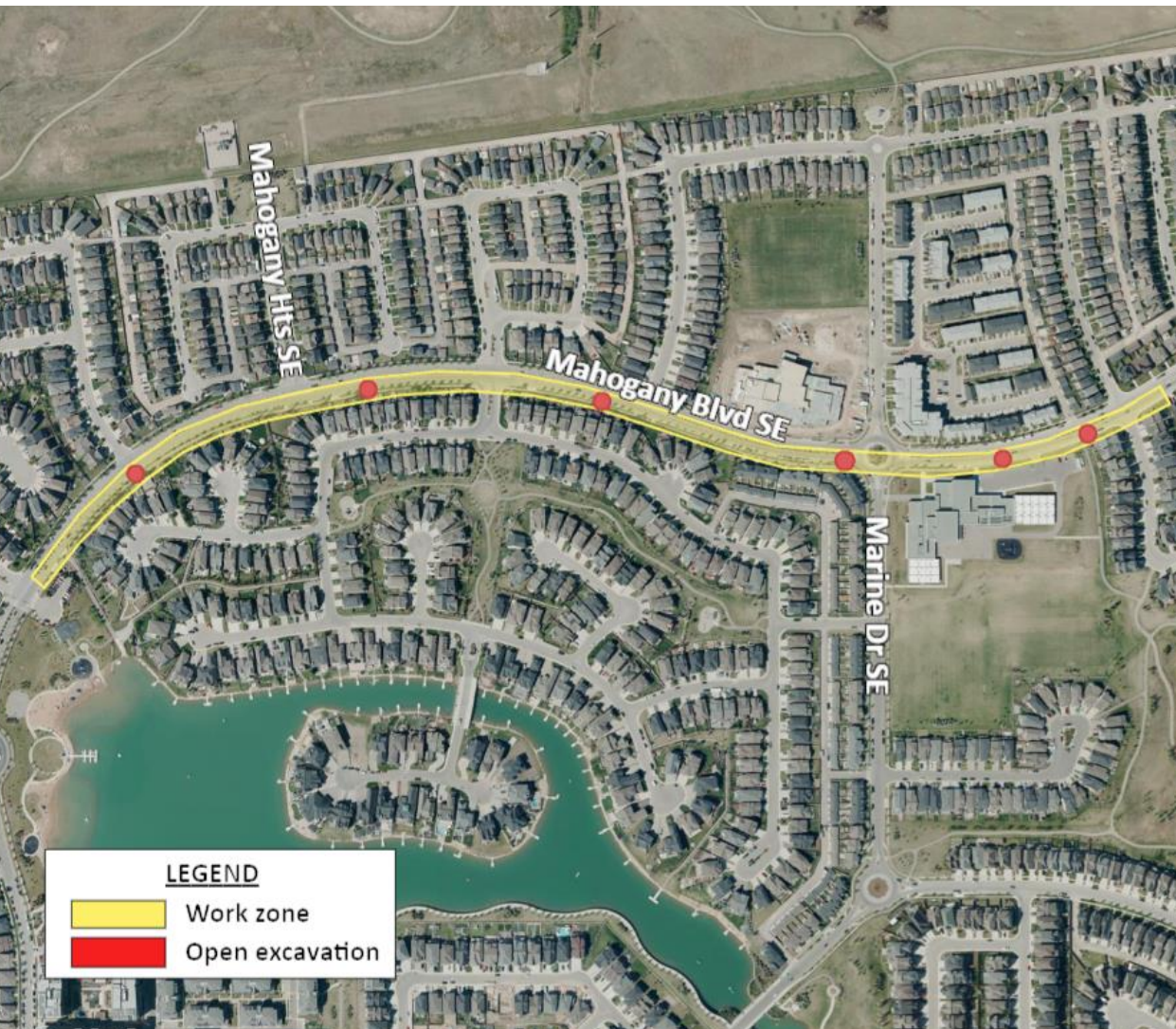


MAHOGANY BLVD SE

What to expect:

We make every effort to minimize the effect our work has on daily activities, and we follow all applicable standards and bylaws. Please to be aware of the project impacts below.

During construction:

- ENMAX and contractor vehicles, hydrovac trucks and associated utility equipment will be onsite.
- Construction barricades and/or safety fencing.
- Project and/or road signage.
- Noise and/or minor vibrations during construction.
- Trees growing too close to electrical equipment may be trimmed for safety.

Power outages:

- A planned power outage will be required for this project.
- If your address is impacted, you will receive a separate notification in advance outlining important outage information.

Road closures, detours, parking, and access:

- Single lane closure eastbound along Mahogany Boulevard SE; please follow onsite signage and detours (if required).
- Pedestrian pathways will be impacted along the south side of Mahogany Boulevard SE; please follow onsite signage and detours (if required).

After construction:

- Concrete pouring and pavement repairs will occur once work is completed (weather permitting).
- Impacted green space will be repaired with grass seed and loam once work is complete (weather permitting).
- Ongoing maintenance of repaired areas on private property is the responsibility of the homeowner/property manager.
